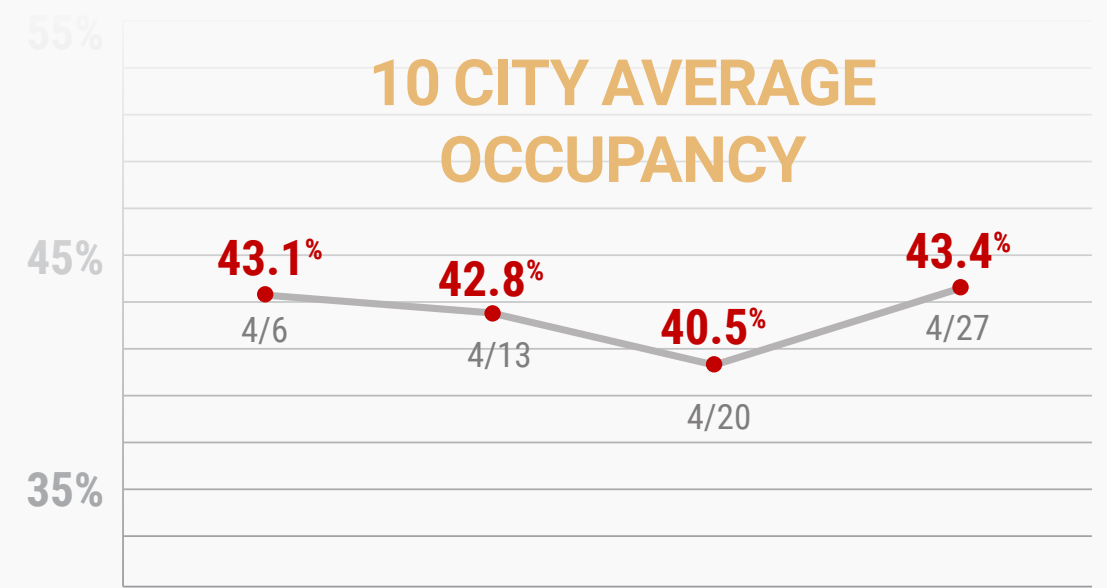


WHERE ARE AMERICANS WORKING TODAY?

THE BIG QUESTION: WORK REMOTELY OR IN-PERSON?

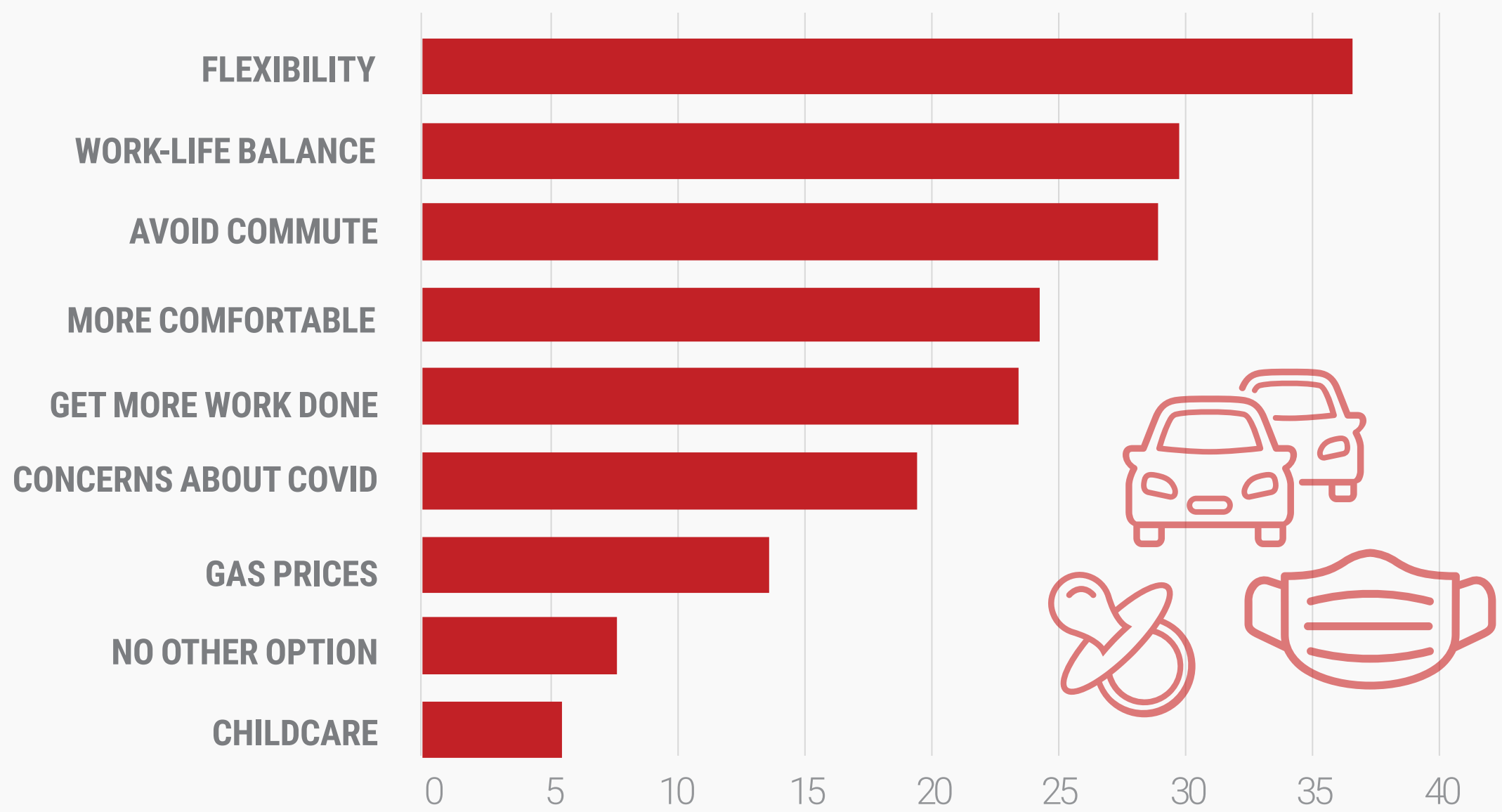
Many companies and organizations have adopted flexible work-from-home policies and hybrid models, leading to lower occupancy rates compared to pre-pandemic levels.
